They have a 13 game winning streak with a 14-1 record. Their game team captains were, Caleb Flagg, Kent Battle, Jhalyn Bailey and Xavier Owens. Saturday if Coach Jon Kay's Eastside Boys are successful he'll set a new record for coaching 3 teams in winning 6A D1 championship titles. He's also

yd pass play to junior wide receiver David Amador for their first of 7 TD's.


The Mustangs explosive offense garnered 500 yds, passing for 122 yards on 11 passes averaging 73 percent completions. The running game produced 374 yds averaging 7.5 yds.

TD's were made by, Kaleb Bailey-2, David Amador-2, Xavier Owens-1, Javin Logan-1 & Jayven Anderson-1 interception TD. Carlos Dominguez kicked the 7 extra points and Andres Montes Zamora made the 7 kickoffs.

The defense continues to dominate their opponent's offense holding the Cavaliers to 3 TD's and 229 yards combined passing and running and only 11 first downs. They've held their five playoff opponents to a mere 88 points while the offense ran up 222 points.

North Shore takes on Duncanville in the 6A Div 1 State Playoffs Saturday, Dec. 18, 2021, 3:00 PM in the Panthers backyard, 17 miles away from AT&T Stadium They've heat them twice (2018 & 2019), the last time they played for the championship in 2019 Governor Greg Abbott was on the Panthers sideline rooting them on. 

ASK DIAMOND JIM

Diamond Jim: "I'm so confused. Why do the jewelry stores at the malls offer big discounts?"

The 30-50-70% off banners hang everywhere in the malls and "big box" jewelry stores. I believe that most customers KNOW those discounts are a sham, and don't really believe that they are getting 60-70% off the ORIGINAL price at all. But many still believe they are getting SOME kind of a deal, whether true or not. I personally am not a fan of discounting because it presumes one of three things:

1) The customer is getting a real deal, in which case I wonder where the margins will come from to run the business. Good for the consumer, bad for the store.

2) You can compete long term on a "lowest price" model. But there is generally only one winner in that game.

3) The "lowest price" model is actually misleading and illusionary. There likely would be enough customers who are smart enough to see through that, and ultimately it will reflect very poorly on the store in the short and long term.



Retail stores will choose for themselves which is the best course for them, be it price value or non-price value. But whichever direction one chooses, I believe it ought to have at its core the basic premise of price integrity!!! 70% OFF may appear to work for them in the short-term... but it is not a sound strategy for longterm growth or for customer loyalty. It is generally simply a lie, even when a store is going out of business! I prefer to have integrity in pricing...and deal with those stores that have integrity in pricing. I have devoted my business life to providing quality and value for a fair price. When on the other side of the counter I always ask myself... is it the truth... and is it fair? I do the same when behind my own counter. I think consumers should do the same when choosing where to spend their money and give serious consideration to truth and integrity in pricing. And if a busines chooses to price its products appropriately and fairly and sell on value, while full well knowing it won't win the customer who is hell-bent on getting a "deal", then that company should owe no apology to anyone for that strategy. The store with the most integrity in pricing will more than likely have the same values an integrity in all of its dealings with you. And THAT is the store with which I choose to do business






