## ASK DIAMOND JIM

Diamond Jim: 'What Exactly is "White Gold" and How is it Made?"

White gold is inherently warm in color, and not dead white like platinum. White gold is not found in nature, since the element from the earth is pure yellow gold (referred to as 24 k ). In order to achieve a old Thie, other metals are added to the pure yellow y definition 14 k gold of metals is called an "alloy." By definition, 14k gold means that 14 parts of the 10 parts in the alloy are other metals. The other metals depend upon the final color you're trying to achieve. For example, 14k yellow gold may have copper, silver, and zinc added so that the yellow color is lightened, but still maintained. Rose gold will have more copper so that the coppery hue is achieved. And white gold will have a white metal, such as nickel or alladum added so the resulting aloy is whiter Although the final color of 14 k white gold is white
than pure yellow gold, 14 parts out of its total 24 parts are still yellow gold. I like to compare it to a bucket paint: It's like adding as much white paint to a bucket of yellow paint as you can. The resulting color will look much whiter, but that yellow paint in the bucket still remains. The same is true of white gold; It will appear whiter but its undertone is still yellow gold. Why is it that sometimes a white gold ng will turn warmer in color over time?
Sometimes that original warmer color is harder to see since our eyes are distracted by shiny things!
Rings often start out polished, and the reflective surface makes subtleties in color hard to see. But as it's worn, the ring's surface becomes scuffed up, and that reflective surface dulls. White gold's inherent color is easier for us to see due to the duller, less distracting surface. Additionally, although most of the metals in the white gold alloy do not tarnish turn colors due to exposure to oxygen), there are tin white cold can "turn" a slightly warmer color with time. Having the ring professionally polished can make it shiny again. But something to keep in mind is that professional polishing removes a layer of metal each time. You wouldn't want to get your ring polished too frequently since it would wear away the gold too quickly. If you prefer a whiter appearance ${ }^{\prime}$ han frequent professional polishing, That way the ring isn't thinned too early in its life, and the fine

Inflation is up, but Homestead ISD Tax Bills are Not! Over 3.5 Million should see savings this Fall

Senator Bettencourt calls on Cities and Counties to adopt the No-New-Revenue-Rate this Fall Taxpayers should visit the State's New Tax Portal to get their Estimated Property Tax Bill

Austin, TX - Senator Paul Bettencourt (RHouston) says that while the current National inflation rate is $8.6 \%$, millions of under-65 Texas District (ISD) tax bills cut this Fall.
In May of last year, Texas' Voters overwhelmngly approved Propositions 1 and 2 , which homestead tax bills in 2022 and 2023. 2.1 Million ver-65 or disabled homeow rate for school maintenance and operations M\&O) in 2023. Proposition 2 increased the statewide school homestead exemption from $\$ 25,000$ to $\$ 40,000$, meaning that over 3.5 million under-65 homestead homeowners will receive thi tax cut this year. My Senate office calculations ndicate an actual cut of $\$ 44$ on average for an verage $\$ 301,000$ taxable homestead in Texas espite massive appraised value increases across the state. An office survey of the top 25 SDs in 8 . These calculated cuts comes before Cities and Counties set their tax rates in the Fall, which could save the average taxpayer hundreds of more dollars on their tax bills.
"The Cavalry is coming over the Hill for Texas Homesteads in the Fall, just like in an old John aayne movie!" said Senator Paul Bettencourt. "Because of the passage of Prop 1 and 2 in May, .5 Million homesteads will on average pay less on their school tax bills this year than they did ast year. Over-65 homeowners are frozen this year, but will get an actual property tax cut in 2023, too." He added.
Property Appraisals are rising amidst a booming Texas economy, but taxpayers can be assured that property tax rates are on the way down to ignif these increases. This is attributed to the gat the lerorms contained in SB 2 and additional property tax legislation that was assed in 2021. In fact there are 16 cents of property tax relief, overall a $\$ 482$ savings comared to last year's tax rate
"Lawmakers have given property owners aluable protections against rising tax bills in this red hot real estate market, but there is no ubstitute for vigilance. Taxpayers must be jurisdictions if they believe tax rates are too high" stated Dale Craymer, President of Texa Taxpayers and Research Association. Note: TTARA supplied county and city penny rate reduction estimates
The no-new-revenue-rate is the rate that provides the same amount of money to a taxing an to extra last year. As Texans are very high inflation, government entities should be doing the same thing or go to the voters for adoption. "I am calling on all Cities and Counties to adopt the no-new-revenue-rate, it will save the taxpayers' money!" concluded Senator Bettencourt.

## House OKs \$302 Billion Budget

The Texas House approved

Greg Abbott's plan to establish a school voucher system. The Austin American-Statesman reported joined nearly all House Demorats to pass the amendment, while 11

The amendment's sponsor, state Rep. Abel Herrero, D-Rob-
stown, said his proposal to block using public money for private schools boiled down to "public money for public schools." The House's budget now heads to the Senate, which has aassed an education reform bill ing a year for a student who atends a private school. Since that funding is not included in he House budget, the issue could lead to tense conference committee negotiations between makers have speculated the conflict could lead to a special called legislative session after e regular term ends on Memo ial Day.
Among the highlights of the House budget are record
unding increases for public schools and highway contruction, as well as raises for tate employees.

## LAN PASSES SENATE

The Texas Senate has passed a controversial plan to build more natural gas-powered
plants in the state, despite widespread opposition from critics who say the two bills could lead to billions in added costs to cusomers. The goal of the bills, acavoid another massive power outage such as the one in the winter of 2021 that killed more than 200 people, the Texas Tribune reported.
 Chronicle columnist Chris Tompeople who testified on Senate Bill 6 voiced opposition. The lants would sit idle at least $9 \%$ of the time.


TEXAS PRISONS
The indoor temperature inside at least 15 state-operated
jails and prisons exceeded 100 degrees last summer, according to a report by The Dallas Morning News. The data indicates that both inmates and staff are heat in the state's facilities that do not have air conditioning. A lack of climate control has contributed to the deaths of nearly two dozen inmates be-
tween 1998 and 2012 , according to the Texas Department Criminal Justice, as well as the heat-related illnesses of dozens of prison guards. The News reported that state standards say county jails
and animal shelters should get no hotter than 85 degrees, but Texas prisons are not required to have air conditioning.
While previous atter While previous attempts to fund air conditioning for the
state's prisons have failed, the state's prisons have falled, the
House budget passed last week sets aside more than a half-billion dollars for that purpose. In addition, two bills to install cooling systems in the prison sys-
tem were approved in tem were

TENTATVE SETTLEMENT IN TEXAS CHURCH SHOOTING The Justice Department last
week announced a tentative $\$ 144$ million settlement with $\$ 144$ milion settlement with 2017 mass shooting at a church in Sutherland Springs, the Associated Press reported. More than two dozen people were killed when a former U.S.
airman opened fire during a church service. It was later determined that the gunman had been able to purchase firearms despite a criminal history.
Three years earlier, while in the Air Force, he was convicted of assaulting an ex-wife and stepson, cracking the child's skull. He was discharged for bad conduct.
The Air Force had previousy acknowledged it was remiss
in not putting the felony conviction for domestic violence in into the FBI database, which could have prevented the shooter from buying guns from a licensed firearms dealer.
